Relative Neighbor Provider Mandated Reporter Training

Required by June 30, 2015

Effective Dec. 31 2014, persons mandated to report suspected child abuse must complete three hours of mandated reporter training by June 30, 2015. As a child care provider you are considered a "mandated reporter." You must complete a web-based training, "Recognizing and Reporting Child Abuse: Mandated and Permissive Reporting in Pennsylvania" accessible at www.ReportAbusePa.Pitt.edu. This training details your reporting responsibilities and takes about three hours to complete. In addition, course completion counts as three hours toward your 12 hours of required Relative/Neighbor training. When you complete the course, you will be presented with an on-line Certificate of Completion. **You must print this certificate immediately upon completing the course and provide it to CCIS of Delaware County by June 30, 2015.** It is advised that you maintain a copy for your records. . Attention Providers: School Age Enrollments

All school age children who are enrolled part-time and receiving a blended rate will have full-time schedules effective June 15, 2015. Please review your attendance invoice to determine that school age children who are eligible to receive full-time care are listed as full time on your invoice as of **June 15, 2015**. If there is a schedule issue please have parents contact their caseworkers immediately to resolve the issue.

Attention All Providers:

Faxed Invoices

If you fax your invoice by the 5th of June, please call no later than Monday June 8, 2015 to ensure that we have received your invoice.

If you fax your invoice, it is YOUR responsibility to ensure receipt.

Please call the CCIS office to CONFIRM that your invoice was received. Please do not assume because you have a confirmation your fax was received. We often receive faxes that are blank or too dark to be read. If you have the confirmation and we can't read your fax—We did NOT receive it. However, please wait at least 5 hours after faxing your invoice before calling the CCIS office for confirmation. The waiting period will ensure that we have ample time to log all the invoices received. If you find that we did not receive your invoice **AFTER** you faxed it: You will need to provide the confirmation sheet (that has the OK) along with your resubmitted invoice by

Monday Afternoon June 8, 2015.

ACCESS Admission

A new initiative from Art-Reach is tailored to meet the needs of individuals who manage their government assisted funds (for SNAP, Medicaid, PH95, etc.) with an EBT/ACCESS Card. ACCESS Admission invites ACCESS Cardholders and their families to visit over 15 local museums, gardens and historic sites, at a deeply discounted rate. Simply by showing their ACCESS Card with a photo ID upon entry, cardholders will enjoy general admission during all days and hours in which a participating museum is open to the public, for just \$2. Bring up to three guests, and they'll enter for just \$2 per person, too. Admission is to be paid by the visitor, not through the EBT card.

Please note: Visiting cardholders must present their valid ACCESS Card and a matching photo ID to receive the discount. One (1) ACCESS Card admits up to four (4) family members at a rate of \$2 per person. Admission is to be paid by the visitor, not through their EBT card. The ACCESS admission discount is not valid on special exhibitions or features, or with any other offers or group rates.
