The AIDS Consortium of Delaware County (ACDC) is an open coalition of individuals, agencies and government working together to provide the quality, range and accessibility of services needed by consumers in Delaware County. Created in 1991, our purpose and activities are guided by this Mission:

- To provide a forum for coordination of services to the target population,
- To assess local needs for prevention, intervention and treatment,
- To conduct planning activities to address identified needs,
- To identify and coordinate resources for plan implementation,
- To represent the strengths and needs of the Delaware County service system at the regional level.

A great many services and resources have been developed for you in Delaware County. Through the efforts of ACDC, they are organized around a system of case management services and coordinated through the cooperative efforts of all of our provider agencies. Any of the agencies listed in this brochure will be able to provide you and your family, friends or caregivers with information about HIV and the various services available to you.

If you are newly diagnosed, or are requesting HIV services for the first time in Delaware County, we would urge you to contact one of the case management agencies directly or the Case Management Uniform Access Project, which can refer you to a local agency of your choice. The telephone number for CUAP is 1-800-929-5602. Case management services are available as you need them for information, support, service planning, referrals, service coordination and advocacy. Some of you may receive case management through drug and alcohol, mental health, mental retardation or children's service systems. HIV case managers will coordinate but not duplicate the other services you receive.

If you are interested in talking with other consumers, you will find some support groups available in the county. Also, there is the consumer led consumer group, New Voices. Any service provider should be able to give you information about the time, date and location of upcoming consumer meetings.

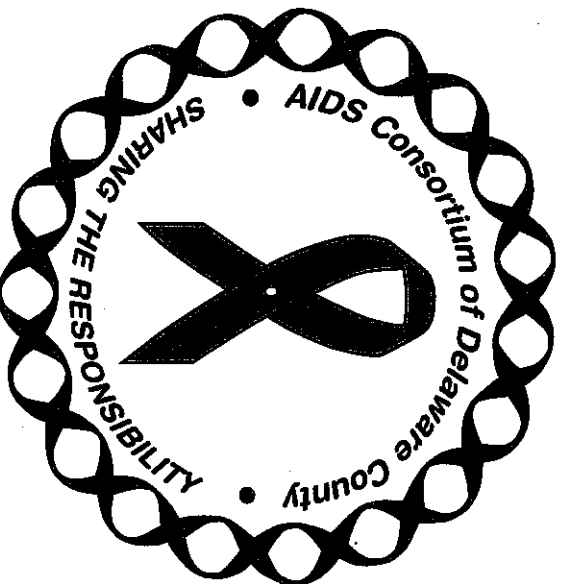
