In an effort to support our Delaware County community during the COVID pandemic, Elwyn has opened up our Warm Line (855-464-9342) to operate 24 hours a day, 7 days a week. Individuals working or living in Delaware County can use this resource to discuss the impact COVID-19 is having on them by calling 855-464-9342 to speak to a mental health counselor. **This resource is in addition to the peer-run Warm Line which will continue to operate during normal hours.** The call is confidential and may be anonymous if the caller prefers. We recognize there are fewer personal resources available to all of us during these trying times. We hope opening this resource will help to assist our community with some of the loneliness, isolation, grieving, fear and other emotions many of us are experiencing.
